ART/DESIGN ENROLLMENT

Chart 1, Chart 2, and Chart 4 provide information on art/design major enrollment, number of degrees awarded in art/design, and percentage of credits generated in courses designed for non-art/design majors.

Chart 1 includes the number of institutions offering a specific major, art/design major enrollment in major areas for Summer 2005 and Fall 2005, and the number of degrees awarded during the period July 1, 2004 to June 30, 2005.

Example: Chart 1-2 - "Total Art/Design Student Enrollment, All Institutions," Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree Programs or Equivalent (65% Art/Design Content). During 2005-2006, 117 institutions offered majors in Graphic Design. In those schools, 2,616 major students in Graphic Design were enrolled in Summer 2005; 12,244 were enrolled in Fall 2005; and 2,678 Graphic Design major students graduated between July 1, 2004 and June 30, 2005.

Chart 2 is a synopsis of Chart 1 by size and type of institution. There are three charts: private institutions, public institutions, and all institutions. There is also a figure in each chart for total enrollment (all programs) in that category of institution.

Example: Chart 2-9 - "Art/Design Major Enrollment by Size and Type of Institution," Public Institutions, 201-400 Majors. Forty-eight schools in this category offer baccalaureate liberal arts degree programs in art/design. In those schools, 1,507 art/design major students were enrolled in Summer 2005; 6,095 were enrolled in Fall 2005; and 1,137 students graduated between July 1, 2004 and June 30, 2005.

Chart 4 analyzes the percentage of credit hours (either quarter or semester hours) generated by non-art/design major students.

Example: Chart 4 - "Percentage of Semester Hours Generated by Non-Major Students," Public Institutions, Over 400 Majors. The average percentage of semester hours generated by non-art/design major students in institutions in this category was 27%. The percentiles also provide a range of data for comparison.

ART/DESIGN FACULTY NUMBERS

Chart 5 through Chart 13 provide a variety of calculations of the number of full-time faculty members. The charts calculate the number of faculty members by gender, highest degree earned, academic rank, length of service at the same institution, and tenure status. There is also a chart (12-2) that shows the number of institutions that do not maintain a tenure system.

***Example:** Chart 10 - "Art/Design Faculty by Gender and Length of Service: Institutions Categorized by Type of Support," Private Institutions, Women.* At the 73 private institutions reporting faculty data by gender, 309 female faculty members have been employed full-time for 1-4 years, 226 have been employed for 5-9 years, and 394 have been employed for 10 years or more at the same institution. These figures are based on a total of 929 female faculty members at private institutions, representing 41% of all faculty at schools that reported faculty data by gender.

In many of the charts in this section, total rows have more entries than the sum of the men and women rows because some respondents were unable to provide faculty data by gender. For the same reason, the "male" and "female" charts are not all-inclusive.

AND PART-TIME FACULTY DATA**

Chart 14 through Chart 19 provide data on salaries for faculty members, and more detailed information on part-time faculty members.

Chart 14 through Chart 16 provide salary statistics for the 2005-2006 academic year by rank for male, female, and all full-time faculty members. The charts include lowest and highest individual salaries, as well as average institutional salaries and the various percentiles. Salaries are based on a nine-month academic year excluding benefits.

Example: Chart 14-2 - "Full-Time Faculty Salaries: Male," Public Institutions, 101-200 Art/Design Majors. Sixteen institutions in this category reported male Associate Professors. Their average salary was \$50,176. The lowest individual salary of any male Associate Professor of Art/Design in this category was \$37,008 and the highest individual salary was \$76,186. The remaining figures represent percentile rankings of average salaries for male Associate Professors employed by institutions in this category.

Chart 17 through Chart 19 provide data on part-time instruction at each school: average number of persons employed, average full-time equivalence (FTE), average part-time salaries, and average percentage of total instructional FTE (full- and part-time). There are sections for part-time faculty with faculty status (individuals who have rank and are considered faculty members by the institution), adjunct faculty and teaching associates (individuals without faculty rank who teach at the institution and who are not graduate students), and graduate teaching assistants and teaching associates (graduate students who teach courses at the institution). Chart 17 provides data for part-time male faculty, Chart 18 provides data for part-time female faculty, and Chart 19 covers all part-time faculty.

Example: Chart 19 - "Part-Time Instruction: All Part-Time Faculty," Adjunct Faculty or Teaching Associates, Private Institutions, 201+ Art/Design Majors. At 42 institutions in this category with part-time adjunct faculty or teaching associates, the average number of persons was 125.40. The average combined part-time workload of all adjunct faculty or teaching associates at an institution was 44.88. The average salary expenditures for individuals in this category was \$8,959; and adjunct faculty or teaching associates represented an average of 44% of the total instructional FTE.

ART/DESIGN ADMINISTRATION

Chart 20 and Chart 21 provide information on salaries for art/design executives and assistant/associate art/design executives for the 2005-2006 academic year. There are separate charts for salaries based on nine or ten months (Chart 20) and eleven or twelve months (Chart 21). The charts reflect gross yearly salary only and do not include benefits.

Example: Chart 21 - "Art/Design Executives' Salaries Based on Eleven or Twelve Months," Public Institutions, 401+ Art/Design Majors. Fifty-nine institutions reported art/design executive salaries in this category. The average salary was \$111,461. The range of salaries from the 5 percentile to the 95 percentile was \$70,472 to \$178,477. Additional percentile figures are also included to analyze the range of salaries.

Chart 22 describes the appointment process for art/design executives.

Example: Chart 22 - "Art/Design Executives' Appointment Process," Public Institutions, 201-400 Art/Design Majors. Of the 52 institutions in this category reporting, 57% of art/design executives are appointed by the administration; 64% are elected by the faculty; and 89% are subject to formal faculty review on an average of every 3 years.

Chart 23 analyzes the average amount of time spent on specific responsibilities by art/design executives and assistant or associate art/design executives.

Example: Chart 23 - "Executives' Job Analysis: Average Percentage of Time Spent," Private Institutions, 201+ Art/Design Majors. Art/design executives at 56 institutions in this category spend an average of 6% of time teaching, 7% in research/creative activities, 67% in administrative matters, 7% in service-related functions, and 13% in fundraising. Assistant or associate art/design executives at 45 private institutions with 201+ art/design majors spend an average of 18% of time teaching, 11% in research/creative activities, 61% in administrative matters, 5% in service-related functions, and 3% in fundraising.

Chart 24 provides data on personnel assignments in the areas of secretarial/clerical assistance, library staff, and professional/technical staff.

Example: Chart 24-1 - "Art/Design Administrative and Staff Assistance," Public Institutions, 101-200 Art/Design Majors. At 25 institutions, the average full-time equivalent (FTE) secretarial/clerical staff was 1.01, with an average salary expenditure of \$110,400. For art/design main library staff, the average FTE at 10 institutions was 0.72, with an average annual salary expenditure of \$41,636.

ART/DESIGN BUDGET

Charts 25-1 through 25-11 provide information on expenses for specific budget categories of art/design units by size (number of art/design majors) and type (public or private). Charts 25-1 to 25-5 include private institutions, Charts 25-6 to 25-10 include public institutions, and Chart 25-11 covers all institutions. In all cases, the charts represent average expenses and percentile rankings for various budget categories and totals.

Example: Chart 25-1 - "Expenses of the Art/Design Unit: All Private Institutions," Specific Instructional, Operational, and Exhibition Expenses, Faculty/Professional Travel. Seventy-five private institutions included faculty/professional travel in their 2005-2006 art/design unit budget. The average expense was \$103,217. Also included in the chart are percentile rankings.

Charts 26-1 through 26-11 provide information on specific sources of income for the art/design unit by size and type of institution. Charts 26-1 through 26-6 include private institutions, Charts 26-7 through 26-10 include public institutions, and Chart 26-11 covers all institutions. The data included in these charts are not meant to represent the total income of the art/design unit, but instead reflect specific types of income generated specifically for the art/design unit.

Example: Chart 26-5 - "Specific Income Sources for the Art/Design Unit," Private Institutions, Over 200 Majors. Twenty-three institutions in this category received public grants, the average of which was \$284,934. Thirty-six institutions received foundation/corporation support specifically for their art/design unit, with an average amount of \$423,745. Forty institutions reported private gifts to the art/design unit with an average amount of \$647,542. Nineteen institutions generated income from ticket sales, commissions, and rentals with an average of \$429,886. Percentile rankings are presented in each category to delineate the range of responses.

ART/DESIGN RATIOS

Charts 35 through 40, and Chart 43 provide further calculations of data derived from the data survey. Each chart analyzes two aspects of the art/design unit's operation in order to make operational and budgetary comparisons.

Chart 35 provides semester and quarter credit hour production per FTE faculty member, including both full- and part-time faculty.

Chart 36 provides instructional salaries for both full- and part-time faculty per semester and quarter credit hour.

Chart 37 provides total expenditures per semester and quarter credit hour production.

There are two parts to each of these three charts: one for institutions reporting semester credit hour systems and one for institutions reporting quarter credit hour systems.

Example: Chart 37 - "Total Expenditures Per Semester Credit Hour," Public Institutions, 1-100 Art/Design Majors. At 13 institutions in this category, the average expenditure per semester credit hour was \$256. The percentile rankings are also provided.

Charts 38 through 40, and Chart 43 provide ratios using total number of art/design majors as their bases. The figures used to develop the ratios are reflected in "Total Expenditures Per Art/Design Major Student" (Chart 38), "Number of Art/Design Majors Per Full-Time Faculty Member" (Chart 39), "Number of Art/Design Majors Per FTE Faculty Member" (Chart 40), and "Average Instructional Salary (Full- and Part-Time) Per Art/Design Major Student" (Chart 43). Each of these charts is presented in two versions: one covers institutions divided by size and type, and the other is based on the highest degree offered in art/design.

Example: Chart 39 - "Number of Art/Design Majors Per Full-Time Faculty Member," Highest Degree Offered in Art/Design: Baccalaureate. At 91 baccalaureate degree-granting institutions, the average number of art/design majors per full-time faculty member is 22.4. The percentile rankings are also provided to develop a range of responses.

ART/DESIGN FACULTY TEACHING LOADS

Chart 44 provides information gleaned from the 2005-2006 survey's Addendum on Faculty Teaching Loads.

The section entitled "Teaching Load Rates and Conversion Ratios" includes data concerning average teaching assignments in credit hours.

Example: *Chart 44-1 – "Teaching Load Rates And Conversion Ratio," Average Teaching Assignment in Credit Hours, Public Institutions, 400+ Art/Design Majors.* Based on 69 public institutions with more than 400 art/design majors reporting, the average teaching assignment in credit hours was 9.3. The percentile rankings are also provided.

The section entitled "Faculty Responsibilities" provides data covering such activities as faculty creative productivity or research, preparing students for exhibition or portfolio presentation, supervising student teaching, advising theses/dissertations, and participating in committee assignments.

Example: *Chart 44-2 – "Faculty Responsibilities," Prepare Students for Exhibition or Portfolio Presentation, Private Institutions, 201+ Art/Design Majors.* Forty-nine institutions in this category reported faculty members who perform this activity. Of the 15 institutions that assigned credit for preparing students for exhibition or portfolio presentation, the average percentage of load credit assigned was 31.3%. The percentile rankings are also provided.

Charts 60 and 61 provide information concerning the ethnic breakdown of faculty by rank, and students by degree level.

Example: *Chart 60 - "Art/Design Faculty By Rank and Ethnic Characteristics," All Institutions, Associate Professor.* Two hundred nineteen institutions reported a total of 1,461 Associate Professors with an ethnic breakdown as follows: 43 Black, non-Hispanic males, representing 2.9% of the total faculty; 24 Black, non-Hispanic females, representing 1.6% of the total faculty; 1 American Indian or Alaskan Native males, representing 0.1% of the total faculty; 4 American Indian or Alaskan Native females, representing 0.3% of the total faculty; 1 Pacific Islander males, representing 0.1% of the total faculty; 3 Pacific Islander females, representing 0.2% of the total faculty; 28 Hispanic males, representing 1.9% of the total faculty; 10 Hispanic females, representing 0.7% of the total faculty; 626 White, non-Hispanic males, representing 42.8% of the total faculty; 597 White, non-Hispanic females, representing 40.9% of the total faculty; 34 Asian males, representing 2.3% of the total faculty; 25 Asian females, representing 1.7% of the total faculty; 42 males of other race or unknown ethnicity, representing 2.9% of the total faculty; and 23 females of other race or unknown ethnicity, representing 1.6% of the total faculty.
